



Magill Road Asphalt Treatment Trial - feedback

The stamped asphalt trial is underway and we seek your feedback.

As part of the Magill Village project aim to create a 'Village Heart', it is proposed to use a stamped asphalt feature finish on the road to create an entrance statement at both the eastern and western ends of the precinct.

A trial section of the stamped asphalt finish has been installed on Magill Road to the east of Vine Street to demonstrate the product meets key criteria, including durability and performance, notably its skid resistance.



If the trial is successful, the road surface treatment will remain in place to serve as a new 'entrance statement' as part of the upcoming Magill Road redevelopment.
