Kerbing and footpath upgrades commencing

As part of the Magill Village Project kerbing and footpath upgrades will commence on the northern side of Magill Road between Lorne Avenue and St Bernards Road.

The work will commence at Lorne Avenue from Monday 28 February 2022.

These upgrades are expected to be completed by the end of April, weather permitting.

During working hours, driveway access will be impacted for short periods however access will be maintained to properties at all other times.

Hours of work will be Monday to Friday 7 am to 5 pm, with the potential for some works to be undertaken on weekends as required.

Bus stop relocation

On Monday 28 February bus stop 18 North (adjacent Bridgestone Select), will be closed as part of the kerbing and footpath upgrade work. A temporary bus stop will be implemented in front of the Foodland Shopping Complex. Impacts to bus services may occur during construction works. At the completion of the project, bus stops 18 and 19 will be permanently amalgamated into a new 'Magill Village Bus Stop' adjacent the Foodland Shopping Complex and the old Bank SA building. See the image below:

General project information

The Magill Village Project is a streetscape renewal project that incorporates paving, landscaping, tree plantings, new street furniture and road improvement works in the Village Heart (located around the intersection of Magill Road and Penfold/St Bernards Road). The road improvement works will include designated pedestrian crossings, new road surfaces, kerbing and storm water drainage upgrades.

An additional pedestrian crossing will be installed, so to support the safety of pedestrians and road users, a permanent speed limit of 40km/h will be in place through the Village Heart upon completion of this project.
