Campbelltown Australia Day Awards

Senior Citizen of the Year Award

This Award recognises individuals who have made a significant contribution to the Community.

Outstanding contribution and community service includes areas such as education, health, fund-raising, charitable and voluntary services, business, sport, arts, the environment or any other area that contributes to the advancement and wellbeing of the Community.

Eligibility:

- Nominees must be Australian Citizens
- All residents of the Campbelltown City Council area are eligible for nomination, and consideration will be given to non-residents who have made a significant contribution to the Campbelltown City Council community
- To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen and over the age of 60 on 26 January 2024
- There must be a minimum of two Nominators per nomination.

Ineligible:

- Previous recipients of the Award
- Existing Campbelltown City Council Elected Members and their immediate families
- Existing Campbelltown City Council Staff
- Sitting State and Federal politicians and current vice-regal officers
- Immediate family members cannot nominate another family member (ie immediate family is defined as spouse or partner, children, parent, guardian, siblings or grandparents)

Note:

- NO LATE SUBMISSIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE.
- Applications must have 2 nominators and the nominee can only be nominated in one category.
- Award recipients will be selected at the discretion of Council. If nominations are unsuitable, Council reserves the right not to select an Award recipient or consider the nomination under another category.
- Elected Members and Council Staff can nominate a person for any Award.
- Council will also forward the details of their Award recipient to the Australia Day Council of SA to go in the running for the State Awards, presented by the Governor of South Australia.
- Nominator are invited to attend a Workshop and make presentation and / or provide further information through a video recording.
- Photo of Nominee required.
