Commencement of Cats By-Law

Further to community consultation in June 2022, which received strong support from the community, Council now has approval to implement the Cats By-Law which will commence on 1 June 2023.

The implementation of this By-Law aims to promote responsible cat ownership by keeping your cat safer, enabling it to enjoy a healthier and longer life and to reduce the public and environmental nuisance caused by cats.

What the new Cats By-Law means if you are a cat owner:

As of 1 June 2023:

- your cat(s) must be confined to your property overnight from **9pm to 7am.**
- Your cat(s) must be registered via Dogs and Cats Online (DACO), dogsandcatsonline.com.au. Registration will be free until at least 1 July 2024.
- Your cat(s) must **wear identification**. This must include the owner's name and either address or phone number.
- Your cat(s) should not cause a nuisance to other residents by way of noise, odour, urination or defecation.

From **1 January 2024**, your cat(s) must be confined to your property 24 hours a day.

The By-Law generally limits the number of cats owned to two per property. Council acknowledges that some residents already own more than two cats and permission for additional cats may be obtained by contacting Council.

Small grants are available for low-income households to assist with enclosures. For further information visit campbelltown.sa.gov.au/cats. Book a Hard Waste Collection

Have you used this year's hard waste allocation? Each financial year (1 July to 30 June), residents are entitled to both:

- one free hard waste collection of up to 2 cubic metres (2m long x 1m wide x 1m high), the equivalent of a standard trailer load, and
- one free mattress collection of a mattress and/or ensemble base.

Bookings are essential and can be made all year round. Please do not place items kerbside without having a booking.
