2022 Council Elections

Participating in Council Elections is one of the most direct ways you can make a difference to everyday life in our Community.

Enrol to Vote

To be eligible to stand as a candidate or vote for your preferred candidates in the upcoming Local Government elections, you need to be on the Voters Roll by 5pm, 29 July 2022. If you are already on the State Government electoral roll, you will be automatically on Council's election roll. Otherwise, you will need to apply. Visit www.campbelltown.sa.gov.au/enrol.

Nominate

Becoming an Elected Member as Council's Mayor or a Councillor provides an opportunity for you to influence local directions and help create long term, positive outcomes for your Community and fellow residents.

The role of an Elected Member is both rewarding and challenging. It requires commitment, responsibility and accountability; Council terms are for 4 years. With very few exceptions, you can nominate for a position on Council regardless of qualifications, religion, race, gender, experience or profession. Visit www.campbelltown.sa.gov.au/nominate. Nominations open Tuesday 23 August and close 12pm Tuesday 6 September 2022.

Candidate Briefing Session

Council will be conducting a Candidate Briefing Session on Wednesday 10 August (refer advert overleaf for details).

Vote

All voting in Council elections is done by post. Enrolled voters will receive voting papers and candidate information through the mail during October 2022. To vote, complete the details in accordance with instructions enclosed and return your voting papers so that they are received by close of voting at 5pm, Thursday 10 November 2022.

Small Business Grants

Twice a year Council invites local businesses to apply for funding through our Small Business Grant program, aimed at helping new and established businesses in Campbelltown to grow and thrive.

The next round of the Small Business Grants (up to \$5,000) and Mentoring Grants (up to \$500) will be open from 1 – 26 August 2022.

Civil works (undergrounding of powerlines, trenching and installation of conduits for new light poles) at Lower North East Road Campbelltown have recently been completed. Work is now underway to install new light poles before power connections to properties are transferred to the new underground cables. The final phase of the redevelopment will then occur including landscaping, new paving, street furniture and public art.


