Communication Access Symbol Accreditation

We are proud to announce that Campbelltown City Council has recently been awarded the Communication Access Symbol.



The award recognises that Council completed an assessment and demonstrated that staff have the skills to successfully interact with people who have communication difficulties.

Communication access aims to create a world where everyone can get their message across everywhere, regardless of whether they have communication difficulties or not. This symbol helps community members identify places and services that are communication accessible. It gives people with communication difficulties confidence that at these places they will be treated with respect and as valued customers.

The Communication Access Symbol is now displayed at Campbelltown City Council's Offices and is listed on the Scope Directory of Communication Accessible Places.


