By-Laws Review 2023

In accordance with Section 249(7) of the Local Government Act 1999, Council gives notice of making the following By-laws at its meeting of 20 June 2023:

Permits and Penalties By-Law 2023 – to provide for a permit system, to fix maximum penalties in Council by-laws, to clarify the construction of such by-laws, and to repeal certain by-laws.

Moveable Signs By-Law 2023 - to set standards for moveable signs on roads, to provide conditions for and the placement of such signs, to protect public safety and to protect or enhance the amenity of the area of the Council.

Roads By-Law 2023 - to manage public roads.

Local Government Land By-Law 2023 - For the management & regulation of the use of and access to all land vested in or under the control of the Council including the prohibition and regulation of particular activities on local government land.

Dogs By-Law 2023 - For the management & control of dogs within the Council's area. In accordance with Section 249(5) of the Local Government Act 1999, these By-laws take effect from 13 November 2023.
