Keeping your cats safe and happy at home

We would like to thank our community for your efforts in adapting to the Cats By-Law introduced on 1 June 2023, by ensuring your cat(s) remain within your property overnight.

While ensuring the safety of your cat(s), your efforts go a long way in minimising the impact domestic cats can have on the environment and your neighbours.

As a reminder, starting from 1 January 2024, your cat(s) need to remain on your property at all times.

Fire danger season – prepare your property

Fire Danger Season generally runs from 1 December to 30 April. Ensure your property is bushfire ready:

- Maintain lawns and other grasses on your property no longer than 10cm/4 inches
- Remove dead branches, leaves and undergrowth
- Prune tree limbs that are less than two metres above ground
- Remove bark, heavy mulch, wood piles and other flammable materials
- Keep your gutters clear
- Keep flammable chemicals in an enclosed shed away from your house

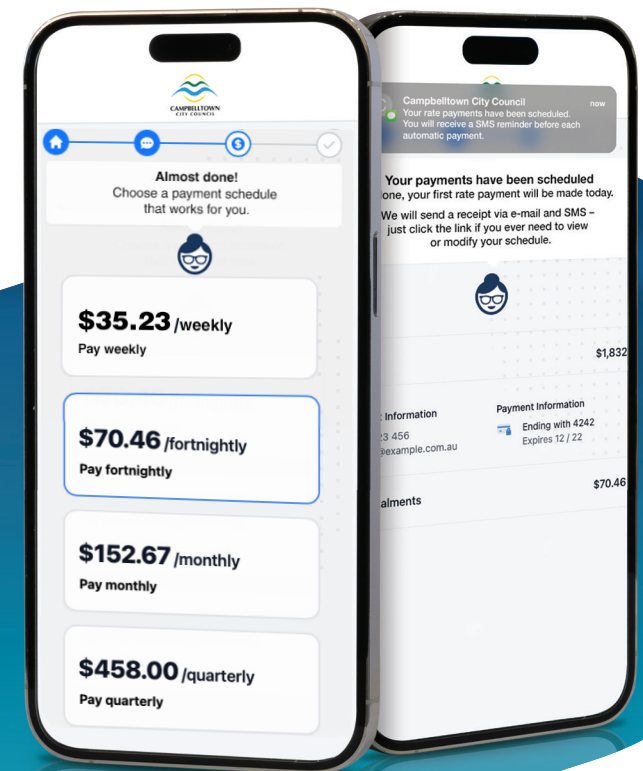
